Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through instant petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.175 dated 24.06.2014, registered under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs & Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (Section 25 of the NDPS Act added lateron), at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

When the Bench considering the facts that petitioner, during trial jumped the bail, declared proclaimed offender and finally arrested after three years; found involved in 3-4 cases of the NDPS Act; in one case he has been convicted and in other cases he is facing trial, was not inclined to grant the concession of regular bail to petitioner, learned counsel prayed for withdrawal of the instant petition.

Dismissed as withdrawn.
