Petitioners are seeking regular bail in FIR bearing No. 60 dated 07.02.2020 under Sections 420/467/468/471/120-B of IPC, 1860 registered at Police Station Sector 29, Gurugram. The allegations as put forth in the FIR are with regard to the preparation of forged Adhaar Cards.

It has been stated that Pawan-petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement alleged by Chitranjan and even Dalip-petitioner has been nominated on the basis of disclosure statement made by the co-accused.

The arrest of Pawan and Dalip-petitioners was effected on 07.02.2020 and 14.02.2020 respectively. The investigation of the case is

complete and the challan has already been presented in the Court. Furthermore,

the offences are triable by the Court of Judicial Magistrate 1st Class, the conclusion of the investigation is likely to take sometime.

Learned State counsel has not disputed the factual position but alleging that some recoveries have also been effected from the petitioners.

Similarly, placed the co-accused namely Sumit Kumar has already been granted bail by the Co-ordinate Bench of this Court vide order dated 12.06.2020 passed in CRM-M-13588-2020.

Without making any expression of opinion on the merits of the case, it is ordered that the petitioners be released on regular bail subject to their furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the concerned trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

The petitions are allowed.
