The petitioner had filed a writ petition being CWP-7337-2020 “*Sunita vs State of Haryana and others*” challenging therein her transfer from Mahendergarh to Mewat. Such petition came up for hearing before this Court on 13.05.2020 on which date this Court issued notice of motion for 05.08.2020 and stayed the effect and operation of the impugned transfer order dated 09.05.2020.

The present petition has been filed for punishing the respondents under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 on the ground that the aforesaid stay order of this Court dated 13.05.2020 has not been complied with.

In response to the notice issued in the present petition the respondents have filed an affidavit through which this Court is informed that the aforesaid interim order of this Court dated 13.05.2020 stands fully complied with as the petitioner has been allowed to rejoin at District Institute for Education & Training (DIET), Mahendergarh.

In view of the above, there is no occasion to pursue any further with the present petition.
