The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.110 dated 30.05.2020 at Police Station Ding, District Sirsa, under Section 15 of the NDPS Act, 1985, wherein the allegations are that 9 kilograms and 280 grams of 'poppy husk' was recovered from accused Kulwant Singh, who later on made a disclosure statement that the same had been supplied by the petitioner.
2. Learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Bhal Singh has informed that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is fully cooperating with the police.
3. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and keeping in view the fact the petitioner has been involved on the basis of

disclosure statement made by co-accused and also that the petitioner is stated to have joined investigation and is fully cooperating with the police, his custodial interrogation would not be required. The petition, as such, is accepted and the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
