In the light of the reply, which has been filed by the respondents, according to which, an amount of ₹8,92,868/- after deducting T.D.S. amounting to ₹36,588/- from the net arrears of pay i.e. ₹9,29,456/- stands released and deposited in the account of the petitioner on 13.07.2020, the present contempt petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of as such.

In case the petitioner has any grievance with regard to the calculations, which have been made by the respondents, he may approach the concerned authorities with his own calculations which shall be looked into by the competent authority by handing him over the details with regard to the calculations which were made to come to the amount of the arrears

which have been released to the petitioner. The said exercise be carried out by the respondents within a period of four weeks of submission of the details relating to the calculations by the petitioners.
