Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

As per pleadings on record petitioner claims himself to be the victim of an online fraud and resultantly being duped of a sum of Rs.43,000/- approximately.

The short grievance raised in the petition is that inspite of repeated complaints having been lodged before the concerned police quarters, no action has been taken till date.

Having heard counsel at length and without even ascertaining the correctness of the averments made in the petition, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the same with a direction to respondent no.6 i.e. S.S.P., Hoshiarpur, Cyber Cell to examine the matter against the backdrop of complaint dated 21.4.2020 (Annexure P-8) which is stated to have already been made and to thereafter take steps as deemed fit and warranted in accordance with law.
