B.S. Walia, J. (VC)

1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Learned counsel contends that the petitioner was made to work as Joint Director (Employment), Haryana, for a period of close to three years but was not paid salary of the said post, besides, although the case of the petitioner had been forwarded for regular promotion to the post of Joint Director, the same was kept pending for want of finalization of ACR for the year 2017-2018. Learned counsel contends that in the meantime the petitioner retired from service and now no action is being taken to decide the claim of the petitioner. Learned Counsel contends that in the circumstances, the petitioner would be satisfied if liberty is granted to the petitioner to move a comprehensive representation to respondent No.1, within a stipulated period of time and directions being issued to respondent No.1 to consider and decide the same in accordance with law in a time bound manner.
3. Notice of motion to respondent No.1 only.

4. Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.1 and states that she has no objection to the limited prayer of the petitioner.

5. Without commenting upon the merits of the controversy or the entitlement of the petitioner to the relief claimed, the writ petition is disposed of by granting liberty to the petitioner to submit a comprehensive representation to respondent No.1 in respect of the grievances which are the subject matter of the writ petition within a period of two weeks from today. In the eventuality of representation being submitted by the petitioner to respondent No.1 within the aforesaid stipulated period of time, respondent No.1 shall consider and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible.
