The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This Criminal Miscellaneous Petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been filed for the issuance of direction to respondent Nos. 1 to 5 to take action against respondent No. 6 in the complaints dated 20.06.2020 and 25.06.2020 (Annexure P-1).

Learned State counsel informs that in pursuance to the order dated 21.08.2020, the statement of daughter of petitioner, namely, Parwinder Kaur wife of respondent No. 6 has been recorded and she has reiterated that she has solemnized marriage with respondent No. 6 and has been residing with him with her own free will.

In this view of the matter, the present petition deserves to be dismissed.

At this stage, learned counsel for respondent No. 6 has pointed out that the petitioner has also registered an FIR against respondent No. 6 and he is repeatedly being harassed by the petitioner as well as by the police.

In view of the above, it is ordered that the proposal of arrest, if any, of respondent No. 6 shall be kept in abeyance for three weeks to enable him to avail legal remedies available to him.

Dismissed.
