On 2.7.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“(the aforesaid presence is being recorded through video conferencing since the proceedings are being conducted in Virtual Court)”

The learned counsel contends that it is a case of cross-version which has been recorded vide DDR No.50 of even date (Annexure P-2). It has further been submitted that co-accused namely Balwant Singh against whom there are allegations in respect of Section 354-B IPC, has already been granted interim bail vide order dated 30.6.2020 passed in CRM-M-17031-2020. It has further been submitted that in any case the only allegation attributed to the petitioner is that he has caused an injury with the help of a ‘kirpan’ and that offence under Section 326 IPC

stands deleted.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Gaurav Garg Dhuriwala, Sr. DAG, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Arresting/Investigating Officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Narinderjit Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 2.7.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
