AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)

Prayer in this petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.127 dated 24.05.2020 registered under Sections 452, 506, 307, 34, 188 IPC at Police Station IT Park, Chandigarh.

It is the contention of learned counsel for the petitioner that the allegations against the petitioner is that he has given an axe blow from the backside on the leg of complainant-Vishal. He contends that the injury, which is attributed to the petitioner has been found to be simple. He was arrested on 24.05.2020 and has completed almost two months in custody. Challan as yet has not been presented and because of prevailing pandemic, the trial is not likely to conclude in near future. He, thus, contends that the petitioner be granted the concession of bail.

Counsel for the Union Territory of Chandigarh could not dispute the factual assertions, as have been pointed out by the counsel for the petitioner.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is in custody since almost two months and the injury, which is attributed to him has been found to be simple in nature, the present petition is allowed.

Petitioner is directed to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Chief Judicial Magistrate/Duty Magistrate, Chandigarh.

Any observations made hereinabove are for the purpose of disposal of the present petition alone and shall have no bearing on the merit of the case during the trial in any manner.
