The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.53 dated 18.01.2019, under Sections 302 and 34 of the I.P.C. & Sections 25 and 54 of the Arms Act, registered at Police Station Model Town, District Panipat.
