This Civil Writ Petition under Articles 226 and 227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent No.2 to grant and release the timings to the petitioners for operation of its route permit, which had been granted to them under the Stage Carriage Scheme, 2016.
