The present petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C for grant of regular bail to the petitioner, in case FIR No. 26 dated 20.1.2019 under Sections 307,34 IPC and 25,54,59 of Arms Act, registered at Police Station P. S. Sadar Gohana, District Sonapat.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the instant case, neither he has been named in the FIR nor any injury is attributed to him. He further contends that the occurrence in question took place on 19.1.2019 and it was after 10 days of the occurrence in question that the petitioner was arraigned as an accused on the basis of concessional statement of Yashu @ Dabbu made before the police.

On the other hand, learned State counsel on instructions from Sub Inspector Rajinder Singh while opposing the grant of regular bail to the petitioner has not been able to controvert the factual aspect of the

submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioner. Learned State counsel has conceded that the injury suffered by the complainant has not been attributed to the petitioner.

Heard.

In view of the submissions made by learned counsel for the petitioner and keeping in view the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 1.3.2019 and till date only three out of the 19 prosecution witnesses cited, have been examined, the trial is unlikely to conclude in the near future, moreso in the prevailing conditions on account of the outbreak of Covid-19, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner. The instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail to the satisfaction of the trial court/Duty Magistrate.
