The instant Petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking Regular Bail in case FIR No.250, dated 06.12.2019, registered under Sections 376, 354D, 341, 506, 34 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 (for short, 'the IPC') at Police Station Women Ballabgarh, District Faridabad.

2. The Petitioner was arrested on 06.12.2019.
3. After completion of investigation Challan against him has already been submitted.
4. It is highlighted on behalf of the Petitioner that the FIR as lodged does not disclose anything constituting the ingredients of any offence under Section 376 of the IPC.
5. Admittedly, the Complainant herself was a mature woman having crossed the age of 25 years when the FIR was lodged and, in any case, the matter has been amicably resolved between the parties in view of

the Compromise (Annexure P-3) arrived at between them on 04.06.2020.

6. Without prejudice to the other aspects of the matter but considering that detention of the Petitioner is certainly not required for investigation purposes and the long imprisonment already undergone by him, he is ordered to be released on bail to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court concerned.
