Prayer in this petition filed under Section 482 Cr.P.C. is for issuance of direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to register an FIR against private respondent Nos.4 and 5.

Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Parminder Singh Bhandal, Superintendent of Police, Phagwara, District Kapurthala, has been filed on behalf of respondent Nos.1 to 3. Perusal of the reply indicates that marriage of the daughter of the petitioner was solemnized on 21.06.2009 with Sarvesh Bhatti, respondent No.4 and on the complaint submitted by the daughter of the petitioner, FIR No.54 dated 15.07.2012 under Sections 406, 420, 498-A IPC was registered at Police Station Rawalpindi, District Kapurthala, against private respondent Nos.4 and 5, but as they did not appear before the trial Court, respondent Nos.4 and 5 have been declared proclaimed offender vide order dated 30.07.2013.

In view of the reply, when FIR has already been registered in the case, nothing survives in the present petition and the same is rendered infructuous.

Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
