Petitioner prays for grant of regular bail in FIR No. 109 dated 19.2.2020 registered at Police Station, Sirsa City, District Sirsa for offence punishable under Section 15 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 (in short "NDPS Act")

Heard.

Notice of motion to the Advocate General, Haryana.

Mr. Apoorv Garg, DAG, Haryana, appears on behalf of the State of Haryana.

The alleged recovery from the petitioner is 12 Kgs of poppy straw whereas another 13 Kgs of poppy straw was recovered from bag of accused Gursewak. The alleged recovery is non-commercial quantity. The petitioner is in custody since registration of the case. Challan has been presented in the court and conclusion of trial is likely to take its own time .

Concededly, there is no other case registered against the petitioner under the NDPS Act.

Without meaning to express any opinion on merits of the

controversy, bail to the petitioner subject to his furnishing bail bonds to the satisfaction of trial court/Additional Sessions Judge (on duty), Sirsa.

However, he shall abide by the following conditions:-

(i)He shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him/her from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer; and

(ii)He shall not leave India without previous permission of the Court.
