Heard.

The present civil writ petition has come about by petitioner Sandeep Bhatia claiming to be successful holder of bid for transportation of food grains for the State of Punjab after being awarded a tender work through legitimate means and that the private respondents No. 4 to 8 are trying to oust him and create hurdles in the smooth transportation of the food grains.

In the light of the same and keeping in view the averments made in the petition and the contentions raised by the counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to ensure due protection of life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of workers and their representatives/goons, which is not opposed by the learned State counsel Ms. Lavanya Paul, Asstt. A.G. Punjab and to ensure that there is no interruption in the free and smooth transportation of the food grains by the petitioner in the light of the terms and conditions of the tender.
