In this Criminal writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, the petitioners have prayed for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* directing the respondent Nos.1 to 5 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioners from the hands of proviate respondent Nos. 6 to 9.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sita Ram submits that the authorities concerned have reported that there exists no threat perception to the life and liberty of the petitioners who are stated to have got married against the wishes of private respondent Nos. 6 to 9.

In these circumstances, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that he does not want to press this petition and the same can be disposed off.

In view of the above, nothing survives in the present petition.

The same stands disposed off.
