This petition has been filed by wife seeking transfer of a petition filed by her husband under Section 13 of the Hindu Marriage Act, titled as "Vinod Goyat v. Udita" from the Court of Additional Principal District Judge, Family Court, Rohtak to any other Court of competent jurisdiction at Bhiwani.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant submits that respondent along with his brother and 4/5 persons came to Bhiwani and took away both the minor daughters with him. The father of applicant has already expired. There is no one in her family to accompany her to Rohtak for attending Court proceedings. She has no source of income and it is very difficult for her to travel from Rohtak to Bhiwani on each date of hearing,

as there is no male member in her family to accompany her.

3. I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

4. Learned counsel for the applicant also relies upon judgment of Hon'ble Apex Court in case titled ***Samita Singh Vs. Kumar Sanjay and another, AIR 2002 SC 396***, wherein it is held that transfer of matrimonial proceedings initiated by the husband against wife, convenience of the wife ought to be looked into.

5. In the premise, present petition is allowed. The petition in question pending before the Court of Additional Principal District Judge, Family Court, Rohtak is ordered to be withdrawn from that Court and is transferred to the District Judge, Bhiwani for its disposal in accordance with law by the Court concerned.
