Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case FIR No.52 dated 17.04.2020, registered under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC, Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 02.07.2020, the petitioner was granted interim bail and was directed to join the investigation. The said order is reproduced hereunder:-

“Case is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0052 dated 17.4.2020 under Sections 307, 326, 325, 324, 341, 148, 149 and 120-B IPC registered at Police Station Sadar Hoshiarpur.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the injury attributed to the petitioner is with datar near the wrist of left arm of the complainant but as per MLR, there is no injury on the wrist of the complainant.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Amit Mehta, Sr. DAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Mr. Partap Singh Gill, Advocate has appeared on

behalf of the complainant.

Learned State counsel, assisted by learned counsel for the complainant, submits that it is a case under Section 307 IPC and total 08 accused attacked the complainant and inflicted injuries on his person. However, it is not disputed that the injury attributed to the petitioner is simple in nature.

Adjourned to 11.8.2020.

To be heard along with CRM-M-14147-2020.

Meanwhile, petitioner is directed to join the investigation and if he is sought to be arrested, he shall be released on interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating Officer/Arresting Officer subject to the conditions as envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that pursuant to the order dated 02.07.2020 passed by this Court, the petitioner has joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Rashwinder Pal Singh, submits that the petitioner has joined investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 02.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
