The petitioner has filed the present writ petition under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India with the following prayers:-

“(I) Prayer for issuance of an appropriate writ, order or directions in the nature of premature release directing the respondent no.2 and 3 to release the petitioner as per the Haryana State notification dated 13th August, 2008 who is legally entitled under the State Government policy (Annexure P/3) for premature release in the interest of justice;

(II)Further directing the official respondents to consider the case of the petitioner, for premature release within specific period, which is already sent by the respondent no.3 on dated 16.10.2019 to the State Government authorities;

(III)Any other relief which this Hon'ble Court may

deem fit in the facts and circumstances may also be passed in favour of the petitioner”

The petitioner was convicted under Section 302 IPC. He was sentenced to undergo imprisonment for life and to pay a fine of Rs.2000/-. An appeal filed against the judgment of conviction and order of sentence was dismissed by the Division Bench of this Court on 19.3.2014.

As noticed above, the petitioner prays that his request for pre-mature release in terms of notification dated 13.3.2008, which has already been recommended, be considered by the competent authority.

Notice of motion.

On the request of the Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the State of Haryana.

Without commenting on the merits of the case, it is considered appropriate to direct respondent no.2 to take a decision on the request so made, in accordance with law, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of the copy of this order.
