1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of Covid-19 pandemic.
2. Prayer in the petition under Section 482 of Cr.P.C. is for directing respondent No.2 to consider and decide representation Annexure P/3 dated 18.05.2020, in a time bound manner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that although a perusal of the FIR reveals commission of offence U/s 307 Indian Penal Code as also under the provisions of the Scheduled Castes and Schedule Tribes (Prevention of Atrocities) Act, 1989, FIR No.152 dated 14.05.2020, has been registered only under Section 336 of the IPC and Sections 25/27 of the Arms Act, Police Station City, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, against respondent No.3.
4. Learned DAG, Punjab, states that already an inquiry is being conducted into the complaint submitted by the petitioner and the same is nearing conclusion.

5. In view of the position as noted above, the petition is disposed of by directing the Inquiry Officer through Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, to consider and decide the aforesaid complaint, as expeditiously as possible and to take action pursuant to the decision in accordance with law, as may be warranted in the facts and circumstances of the case.
