GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of the restrictions due to outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners, namely, Rahul, who is stated to be aged 34 years, Bunt Kumar, stated to be aged 26 years and Mukesh Kumar, stated to be aged 24 years, have jointly filed the present petition *inter alia* with a prayer to grant them anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0144 dated 16.05.2020, under Sections 323, 365, 120-B, 34 IPC registered at Police Station Bawani Khara, District Bhiwani.

Vide order dated 01.07.2020, the petitioners were granted interim bail and directed to join investigation.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Parveen states

that the petitioners have joined investigation and their custodial interrogation is no more required.

In view of the above, the petition is allowed. The order dated 01.07.2020 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners, is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so by the Investigating Agency and shall abide by the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr. P.C.
