The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.0084 dated 10.06.2020 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 IPC registered at Police Station Radaur, district Yamunanagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the loan amount had been cleared by the petitioner even before lodging of the FIR and nothing is due against him.

A Coordinate Bench of this Court, by order dated 03.07.2020, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions from ASI Jasmer Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the submissions of learned counsel for the petitioner especially when the petitioner having joined investigation and the Covid-19 Pandemic, the order dated 03.07.2020 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
