The petitioners have approached this Court by invoking Article 226 of the Constitution of India, for issuance of an appropriate direction as they have apprehension of loss to their life and liberty at the behest of respondents Nos.4 to 6, relatives of petitioner No.1.

Notice of motion to respondents No. 1 to 3.

Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Addl. AG, Punjab appears on behalf respondent Nos. 1 to 3 and states that there is no threat to the lives and liberty of the petitioners at the behest of respondent Nos. 4 to 6.

As per the allegations, petitioner No.1 was earlier married to Manpreet Singh and her husband died on 27.02.2019. The petitioners are stated to be residing together by way of live-in-relationship. Parents of petitioner No.1 want to perform her marriage against her wishes.

Without commenting upon correctness or otherwise of the allegations raised, the petition is disposed of with a direction to the Senior Superintendent of Police, Barnala to look into grievance of the petitioners and take appropriate steps warranted in the circumstances, in accordance with law.
