This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

Petitioners have filed this petition seeking quashing of orders dated 28.11.2019/ 13.01.2020, Annexure P-3 and 03.06.2020, Annexure P-7.

It is brought to my notice by learned counsel for the parties that vide order dated 17.11.2020, the abovesaid impugned orders have been withdrawn and the petitioner has been held entitled to 100% family pension and the pending 50% of the family pension is directed to be released to the petitioner. Order dated 17.11.2020 , reads as under:-

“The State Government has decided that, this office orders dated 28.11.2019/ 13.01.2020 and order dated 03.06.2020 regarding recovery a sum of Rs.19,52,287/- (Nineteen Lacs Fifty Two Thousand Two Hundred Eighty Seven) are hereby withdrawn.

Further Smt. Indrawati is entitled for 100% family pension and the pending 50% family pension may release.”

In view of the above, this writ petition is rendered infructuous and is disposed of accordingly. However, the respondent-authorities are directed to release the pending 50% of the family pension to the petitioner, within four weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order in view of order dated 17.11.2020.
