The instant petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure seeking regular bail in case FIR No.329 dated 06.11.2019, under Sections 120-B, 406, 320, 467, 468, 471 and 506 of the I.P.C., registered at Police Station Sarai Khawaja, District Faridabad.

[2]. The petitioner was arrested on 25.01.2020. Investigation against him has since been completed and challan submitted. A perusal of the FIR goes to show that he was not even named as an accused by the complainant. The alleged incriminating material against him has apparently transpired from the disclosure statement of the prime accused Ratan Bhushan Gupta, who is also in judicial custody.

[3]. *Per se* disclosure statement of co-accused is not admissible in

evidence and apart from such statement, there is virtually no material linking the petitioner to the alleged occurrences.

[4]. In such circumstances, further detention of the petitioner for an indefinite period, at this stage, is not warranted.

[5]. In view of the above, the petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail, subject to the appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
