This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to outbreak of the pandemic, COVID-19.

The petitioner, who was elected as Municipal Councilor from Ward No. 21, Narwana, District Jind, was suspended from the post of Municipal Councilor, vide order dated 23.06.2020. It is submitted that a statutory appeal challenging order dated 23.06.2020 was filed on 25.06.2020 itself, alongwith an application seeking interim relief, before the learned Appellate Authority. However, the matter is not being taken up by the learned Appellate Authority, neither is the said application for interim relief being decided. Learned counsel for the petitioner refers to order dated 31.01.2020 passed in CWP No. 2685 of 2020 and order dated 15.06.2020 passed in CWP No. 8051 of 2020, attached as Annexures P-4 and P-5 with this petition, wherein writ petitions by similarly situated persons as the petitioner, have been disposed of.

Learned counsel for the petitioner also refers to the Division

Bench Judgement of this High Court in **CWP No. 15000 of 1996, titled as**

Kashmir Kaur Vs. Sec., to Government of Haryana Development and Panchayat Department-Cum-Financial Commissioner and others 1997(1) PLR 242.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances as above, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the learned Appellate Authority to consider and dispose of the appeal preferred by the petitioner in a time bound manner, preferably within three months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order. Application for interim relief, filed by the petitioner, be decided by the learned Appellate Authority, within 15 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order and till the decision thereof, order dated 23.06.2020, shall remain stayed.
