The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.170 dated 01.05.2019, under Sections 341, 349-A, 201 IPC, registered at Police Station Hathin, district Palwal.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that it is alleged in the FIR that three unidentified persons had caught hold of the complainant and snatched his motorcycle, mobile phone and ₹2,000/- in cash. He further contends that no recovery has been effected from the petitioner, who is in custody for over 10 months. He also contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in this case and after his arrest in the instant case, he was involved in four other cases wherein he is on bail.

Learned State counsel, upon instructions contends that although challan has been filed but no prosecution witness has been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the petitioner is in custody for over 10 months; no recovery has been effected from him; the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
