Both Vidiya Kaur and Lakhbir Singh have stated that they never sent any complaint and somebody has wrongly informed this Court alleging that Lakhbir Singh has been forcibly taken by the police on 12.06.2020. Smt. Vidiya Kaur states that she does not have any grievance as her son was never forcibly taken by the police.

Keeping in view the above, as no grievance has been raised by Smt. Vidiya Kaur as alleged in the e-mail, which has been treated as criminal writ petition, no further orders are required to be passed in the present petition.
