1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic Covid-19.
2. Grievance in the contempt petition is qua violation of order dated 09.01.2020 passed in CWP No.355 of 2020.
3. Learned counsel contends that CWP No.355 of 2020 i.e. case titled as Hansa Singh versus Punjab State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd., and others was disposed of vide order dated 09.01.2020, by directing respondent No.2 i.e. Principal Secretary, Food and Civil Supplies-cum-Chairman Appellate Authority to decide appeal dated 6.6.2019 on merit within two months of receipt of certified copy of the order.
4. Learned counsel contends that since pursuant to the filing of the contempt petition, the Appellate Authority has communicated decision on the appeal dated 28.05.2020 vide endorsement No.12660 dated

10.07.2020, confirming the punishment imposed, therefore, he does not press the contempt petition and prays for liberty to challenge the order passed by the Appellate Authority in accordance with law.

5. In view of the position as noted above, the contempt petition is disposed of as not calling for any orders with the liberty as prayed for.
