A short reply filed by the respondent is taken on record.

On 6.7.2020, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The petitioner prays for grant of pre-arrest bail in a criminal case arising out from FIR No.148, dated 30.04.2020, registered under Sections 307/341/382/148/149 IPC and Section 25 of the Arms Act, 1959, at Police Station City Ferozepur, District Ferozepur.

Hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated and only allegation against the petitioner is

to the effect that he along with his brother had prevented the first informant and his brother from escaping.

Notice of motion, for 17.07.2020.

On asking of this court, Mr. Jagmohan S.Ghuman, Deputy Advocate General, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the State.

In the meantime, in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be released on interim bail subject to furnishing personal bonds and surety to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

To be heard along with CRM-M-13724-2020.”

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhchain Singh has submitted that the petitioner has joined the investigation, cooperated and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the order dated 6.7.2020 is hereby made absolute.

Petition stands allowed.
