Petitioner Shakuntla Devi mother of deceased Constable Gural Singh in Sashastar Seema Bal has filed a civil writ petition seeking issuance of appropriate directions that service benefits be not released in favour of respondent No.5 including death insurance claim on account of the averments that respondent No.5 was instrumental in the murder of the

deceased. The petitioner claims that she has made representation Annexure P-9 to the official respondents but nothing has transpired since then.

In the light of these contentions, the present petition stands disposed off with the directions to the official respondents to consider and decide representation Annexure P-9 dated 11.03.2020 moved by the petitioner fully in accordance with law by passing a speaking order, which would be duly intimated to the petitioner, preferably, within 02 months on the receipts of copy of this order.
