The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.463 dated 18.10.2019, registered under Sections 148/149/323/325/285/506/458 IPC and under Section 25 of the Arms Act at Police Station Civil Line, District Kaithal.

The FIR was registered at the instance of complainant Sushil Kumar son of Jitender with the allegations that on 17/18.10.2019 at about 12.30 a.m., when the complainant along

with his family members was sleeping in the house, some persons knocked the door and also fired. They entered into the house by breaking open the gate and gave beatings to the complainant, his wife and mother. The assailants took them out from the house and also gave them beatings. The allegations were made against Ajaydeep @ Soni @ Sixer and 8 other persons, who have caused injuries to the complainant-party with *dandas*.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that none was injured by the gun shot in this occurrence. The injuries received by the complainant party attracted the offences under Sections 323 and 325 IPC. The offences except the offences under Section 458 IPC and 25 of the Arms Act are bailable. Petitioner is in custody since 14.05.2020. Co-accused Ajaydeep @ Sonu @ Sixer has already been granted regular bail by this Court vide order dated 04.02.2020 passed in CRM-M No.3964 of 2020.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Kulwinder Singh submitted that a country made pistol has been recovered from the petitioner and the petitioner had fired 2-3 shots in air, but none was injured. Challan has been presented, but charges have not been framed so far.

Taking into consideration the entire facts and

circumstances of the case, particularly in view of the fact that co-accused Ajay deep@ Sonu @ Sixer has been granted bail and in view of the situation arising out due to pandemic COVID-19, I deem it appropriate to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

In view of above, petition is allowed. Petitioner is ordered to be released on bail, subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/concerned Duty Magistrate.

Nothing expressed hereinabove would be construed to be an expression of any opinion on merits of the case.
