The grievance of the petitioner is with regard to non-disposal of his revision pending before the Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala. However, the said revisionary authority is not made a party. This Court accordingly impleads, *suo motu*, the Commissioner, Ambala Division, Ambala, as respondent No.3. Registry is directed to carry out the necessary correction in the cause title before issuing a copy of this final order.

The grievance of the petitioner is that his revision filed under the provisions of the Punjab Village Common Lands (Regulation) Act, 1961, filed as long back as in July, 2019, has not been disposed of. As this Court does not propose to go into the merits of the pending revision, it would not be necessary to put the respondents on notice or afford them an opportunity of

hearing.

When this matter was taken up for hearing on 03.07.2020, the learned State counsel was asked to ascertain as to why the revision had not been disposed of till date.

Today, Ms. Shubra Singh, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, would inform this Court that the petitioner's Revision Petition No.64/YNR of 2019 is fixed for arguments on 15.07.2020. The communication dated 07.07.2020 addressed by the revisionary authority to the office of the learned Advocate General, Haryana, Chandigarh, would indicate that 3 months time was sought for disposal of the revision. However, as the case is coming up for arguments on 15.07.2020, there is no reason as to why the revisionary authority should keep the matter pending for 3 months thereafter. The revisionary authority is accordingly directed to conclude the hearing of arguments on 15.07.2020, as already fixed, and dispose of the revision on merits and in accordance with law within two weeks thereafter.

This revision is disposed of accordingly.

There shall be no order as to costs.
