The present contempt petition is filed for willfully and intentionally disobeying the order dated 9.1.2020 (Annexure P-1) vide which a direction was issued to the Deputy Commissioner, Mansa to consider the claim of the petitioner on merits as per the policy of the Government of Punjab dated 8.11.2011 (Annexure P-1) and the guidelines dated 3.3.2014 (Annexure P-6/A) within a period of three months.

Reply has been filed. As per the same, the order has been complied with by passing of a speaking order dated 27.7.2020.

In view of the same, no further orders are required to be passed in the contempt petition. The same is dismissed as rendered infructuous.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) is discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the said speaking order in accordance with law, if so advised.
