This Criminal Writ Petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.2 and 3 to protect the life and liberty of the petitioner at the hands of respondents No.4 to 7.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that petitioner has already made representation 18.06.2020 to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, Tarn Taran, District Tarn Taran, copy of which is available on the file as Annexure P/5, but still no action has been taken.
