The petitioner is seeking regular bail in FIR No.29 dated 11.01.2017, under Sections 279, 336, 427 IPC (Sections 307, 120-B, 34 and 202 IPC added later on), registered at Police Station Civil Lines, Hisar, District Hisar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner is not named in the FIR wherein it is alleged that a jeep being driven in a rash and negligent manner at a very high speed had hit the car of the complainant. It is a case of no injury. The similarly situated co-accused namely Pawan Bansal has been granted regular bail by the coordinate Bench of this Court in CRM-M-8827 of 2020 on 02.06.2020.

Learned State counsel contends that 2 out of 114 prosecution witnesses have been examined.

Heard through video conferencing.

In view of the submissions of the learned counsel for the petitioner, especially when the co-accused has been granted bail, the COVID-19 pandemic and the conclusion of the trial is likely to take some time, I deem it a fit case to grant the concession of regular bail to the petitioner.

Therefore, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the instant petition is allowed. The petitioner is ordered to be released on regular bail on his furnishing requisite bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned.
