[1]. Petitioner has preferred this writ petition for issuance of an appropriate writ of certiorari for setting aside the order dated 09.05.2020 passed by respondent No.1. Petitioner further seeks issuance of writ of mandamus, directing the respondents to cancel the posting of respondent No.4 from Government Senior Secondary School, Malan to Government Senior Secondary School (Girls), Sri Muktsar Sahib vide order dated 13.04.2020.

[2]. Petitioner was working as Principal, Government Senior Secondary School (Girls), Sri Muktsar Sahib. She retired from

the post after attaining the age of superannuation on 31.03.2020. She applied for extension of service on 19.03.2020. The extension was granted/approved by respondent No.1 on 25.04.2020 w.e.f. 01.04.2020. Petitioner was granted extension upto 30.09.2020. After grant of extension, the petitioner was given posting in government Senior Secondary School, Bhalaiana, District Sri Muktsar Sahib, where she did not join. On the original place of posting of the petitioner, Mr. Jagdish Singh has joined the post on 15.04.2020. When the petitioner did not join the post in Government Senior Secondary School, Bhalaiana, Sri Muktsar Sahib, Mr. Subhash Chander was posted as Principal in Government Senior Secondary School, Bhalaiana, Sri Muktsar Sahib. As on date, petitioner is nowhere posted.

[3]. In the context of grievance of the petitioner, she has statedly moved representation dated 19.05.2020 before the Hon'ble Secretary Education Department, Punjab and no order has been passed.

[4]. Looking to the facts and circumstances of the case, it would be just and appropriate to direct respondent No.1 to look into the matter and pass appropriate order in accordance with law. Petitioner would be at liberty to supplement the representation in question by way of additional representation, if

so advised. Let needful be done within a period of one month from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
