Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.103, dated 05.07.2018, under Section 22 of the NDPS Act, registered at Police Station Samana, District Patiala.
