Case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Through this second petition under Section 439 Cr.P.C. prayer has been made for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in a case arising from FIR No.70 dated 22.08.2019, registered under Sections 22, 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station City Raikot, Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.

Earlier bail petition of petitioner was dismissed on 04.02.2020.

Learned counsel, referring to orders dated 16.01.2020 and 16.06.2020, passed in CRM-M-1687 and 2313-2020, vide which co-accused of the petitioners namely Varinder Kumar @ Bunty and Balbir Singh @ Biru were granted bail, wants that the petitioner may also be granted bail.

The case of the petitioner for bail is altogether different from aforesaid co-accused, inasmuch as, they were not apprehended on the spot, whereas petitioner was apprehended at the spot with conscious possession of 19000 tablets which is an extraordinary quantity beyond imagination. That apart, petitioner is also accused in another FIR No.114, registered in the year 2017, under Section 22 of NDPS Act for having conscious possession of 20,000 intoxicant tablets without any permit or licence. The above heavy recoveries of contraband from the petitioner shows that he is a big smuggler of contraband. Such type of criminals do not deserve the concession of bail. Even otherwise, no ground could be shown by learned counsel for petitioner to entertain this second bail application.

Dismissed.

After pronouncing the order of dismissal, learned counsel for petitioner prays for withdrawal of the petition.
