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JAISHREE THAKUR J. (ORAL)

This is a petition that has been filed seeking to quash the FIR No.489 dated 7.8.2015 under Sections 354-A(1), 323, 341, 506, 509 IPC registered at Police Station Sector 5, Gurgaon on the ground that no offence under Section 354-A(1) IPC is made out.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondent-State as well as the private respondent would contend that the petitioner herein had already approached this Court by way of filing CRM-M No.32809 of 2015 seeking grant of anticipatory bail, which petition was dismissed on 23.09.2015 holding that custodial interrogation of the petitioner herein would be required. Since there was a specific allegation against the petitioner of assault with an intention to disrobe a woman.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to approach the investigating

officer and join investigation.

Consequently, the instant petition is disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to join investigation and shall continue to do so as and when called upon by the investigating officer and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
