**AUGUSTINE GEORGE MASIH, J. (ORAL)**

Having considered the submissions made by the counsel for the petitioners as well as the counsel for respondents and complainant, wherein it has come to light that allegations and counter allegations have been made between the petitioners as well as respondent No.5. In the reply, which has been filed by the State, reference has been made to an earlier inquiry, which was initiated at the behest of respondent No.5, which has been filed. The complaints which have been filed by the petitioners as well as respondent No.5, in the opinion of the Court, are required to be, once and for all, considered and a decision taken on that basis by the competent authority.

Direction is, therefore, issued to the Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to look into all the complaints, which have been submitted by the petitioners as well as respondent No.5 and take a consolidated view on the basis of the said complaints after inquiry, if required.

The said decision be taken within a period of four weeks from today.

be submitted to the Registrar (Judicial) of this Court.

With these directions, the present petition stands disposed of.
