[1]. Petitioner-wife has filed the present transfer application under Section 24 CPC for the transfer of petition filed by respondent husband under Section 13(1)(i-a) & 13(1)(i-b) of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 (in short 'the Act') titled as “Lakshman Singh Vs. Poonam” from the Court of District Judge (Family Court), Pathankot to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Ambala.

[2]. Notice of motion.

[3]. Mr. Ajit Pal Singh Guliani, Advocate, has put in appearance and filed his Power of Attorney on behalf of the respondent.

[4]. After hearing the submissions from both sides, the present application is disposed off by directing transfer of the Divorce Petition (Annexure P-1) filed by the respondent husband from the Court of District Judge (Family Court), Pathankot to that of the District Judge, Chandigarh, who may thereafter decide it himself (as Family Court) or assign the same to any other competent Court in his jurisdiction.

[6]. Both parties may appear before the Family Court at Chandigarh on the date already fixed earlier by the Family Court at Pathankot, i.e., 15.10.2020.
