JITENDRA CHAUHAN, J.

The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure is for granting anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case First Information Report No.83 dated 10.5.2020 registered under Section 15 of NDPS Act at Police Station Rajound, District Kaithal.

Heard.

On 6.7.2020, while issuing notice of motion and granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner, the following order was passed by this Court:-

“The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is not named in the FIR. He has been named by co-accused Sanjay. The total recovery is 9 kg of poppy husk, which is a non-commercial.

Notice of motion for 4.8.2020.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Apoorv Garg, DAG, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

The petitioner is directed to join investigation.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest of the petitioner by the Arresting Officer, he shall be released on interim bail subject to the following conditions:-

- 1) that he shall make himself available for interrogation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2) that he shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3) that he shall not leave India without the previous permission of the Court.”

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Wazir Singh, informs that the petitioner has joined investigation in compliance of the order dated 6.7.2020 and is not required for further custodial interrogation.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed. The order dated 6.7.2020, vide which the petitioner was granted interim anticipatory bail is made absolute subject to his furnishing bail/ surety bonds to the satisfaction of learned Chief Judicial Magistrate/ Duty Magistrate concerned.
