The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jugraj Singh submits that petitioners Gurjant Singh and Jagsir Singh have since been arrested and, thus, the present petition has been rendered infructuous qua them.

Disposed off having been rendered infructuous qua above petitioners.

Further, learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Jugraj Singh submits that in consequence of interim order dated 06.07.2020, the petitioner Gurmeet Singh has since joined the investigation and is no longer required for further investigation and nothing is to be recovered from him and that he has no objection if the interim order is made absolute.

In the light of the statement made by the learned State counsel, the interim bail granted to the petitioner Gurmeet Singh vide order dated 06.07.2020 is made absolute till submission of report under Section 173 Cr.P.C. (challan). Thereafter, petitioner will be permitted to furnish regular bail bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court. The petitioner shall abide by the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

With these observations, the present petition stands disposed off.
