The petitioner has approached this Court seeking directions to the official Respondents no 1 to 4 for taking appropriate action against private respondent no 5 to 10 for interfering in his peaceful married life and threatening to eliminate him and obstructing him from cultivating his fields in retaliation of his getting married to Daljeet Kaur.

2. Petitioner contends the he solemnized his marriage against the wishes of his wife's family. Even prior to their marriage, apprehending threat from family members/friends of his would be wife, he had earlier also approached this Court vide CRM No. M-18473 of 2019, wherein order dated 20.05.2019 was passed by this Court, observing that Daljit Kaur of her free will wanted to live with the petitioner and directions were given to the official respondents not to take any illegal action, contends the petitioner.

3. Petitioner asserts, that his father gave 2-½ acres of land to the petitioner to earn his livelihood, but respondent No.5, who is close friend of the father of Daljit Kaur, along with other private respondents, is not allowing the petitioner to cultivate the said land.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that various incidents have taken place where petitioner as well as his father have been attacked by the family members and family friends of Daljit Kaur. Petitioner made various complaints to the police authorities, but no action has been taken, forcing the petitioner to once again approach this Court.

5. Without commenting on the merits of the case, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3 i.e Commissioner of Police, Ludhiana, to get the threat perception of the petitioner assessed. If warranted, requisite steps then be taken in accordance with law.

6. Let the needful be done within a period of one month from today.

7. Disposed of.
