Matter has been taken up through Video Conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. seeking anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.78, dated 16.04.2020, under Sections 323/324/148/149/427 IPC and Section 326 IPC added later on, registered at Police Station Dharamkot, District Moga.

Counsel has been heard at length.

As per prosecution version, it is the petitioner herein who had inflicted a sword blow on the left ankle of injured Dharminder Singh. Such injury has been opined to be grievous in nature and thereby has attracted offence under Section 326 IPC.

In view of the specific attribution and the seriousness of the offence, this Court is not inclined to grant in favour of the petitioner the

concession of anticipatory bail.

Petition is dismissed.
