Learned counsel for the petitioner alleges that there has been deliberate non-compliance and disobedience of the order dated 17.12.2019 in CWP No. 36496 of 2019 passed by this Court inasmuch as the respondents have failed to pass a speaking order as had been directed by this Court in the aforementioned writ petition.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Deepali Puri, Addl. Advocate General, Punjab, who has joined the proceedings through video conferencing accepts notice on behalf of the State.

Learned State counsel on instructions submits that a decision would be taken on the representation made by the petitioners within a period of two weeks from today.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that keeping in view the statement made by the State counsel, he would not press the instant contempt petition and it may be disposed off as such.

The instant contempt petition is disposed off as having been not pressed. Needless to add that the respondents shall be bound by their statement given in the Court today. It is further clarified that in case, there is a violation of the above recorded statement of the respondent-State and the same is brought to the notice of this Court a strict and serious view would be taken by this Court against the State.
