1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.199 dated 02.06.2020 at Police Station Haibowal, District Police Commissionerate Ludhiana, under Sections 452, 323, 341, 506, 148, 149 of Indian Penal Code.
2. While issuing notice of motion on 14.07.2020, the following order was passed:

“The learned counsel for the petitioner contends that even as per the FIR the petitioner was not armed with any weapon and that the only allegation against the petitioner is that she is alleged to have caught hold of the victims while the co-accused inflicted injuries.

Notice of motion for 17.11.2020.

At this stage, Mr. Ajay Pal Singh, DAG, Punjab, upon whom advance copy of the petition had already been served, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

At this stage, Mr. Chanchal K. Singla, upon whom advance copy of the petition had already been served, accepts notice on behalf of the complainant.

Keeping in view the fact that the petitioner is a lady, it is ordered that in the meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to her furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.”

3. Today, learned State counsel upon instructions from SI Sukhwinder Singh has informed that the petitioner pursuant to the interim directions has joined the investigation and is cooperating with the police.
4. Having regard to the facts and circumstances of the case and in view of the aforesaid position, the interim directions issued by this Court vide order dated 14.07.2020 are hereby made absolute subject to the condition that the petitioner shall join investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
5. The petition stands accepted accordingly.
